You have certain recourse rights if any debit does not comply with this agreement. ## Privacy Notice Statement

The information you provide is collected under the authority of the *Apprentice Loan Act* (ALA) and *Apprentice Loan Regulations* (ALR) for administration of the Canada Apprentice Loan (CAL) program. The Social Insurance Number (SIN) is collected under the authority of the ALR and in accordance with the Treasury Board Secretariat Directive on the Social Insurance Number, which lists the ALR as an authorized user of the SIN. The SIN will be used as a file identifier, and, along with the other information you provide, will also be used to validate your application, and to administer and enforce the CAL.

Participation in the Pre-authorized Payment Plan is voluntary. Refusal to provide personal information will result in no changes to your banking information currently on file at the Canada Apprentice Loan Service Centre for Pre-Authorized Payments, or the Pre-Authorized Payment Plan will not be activated on your account and you will be responsible to make your payments using an alternate payment method.

The information you provide may be shared with the Canada Student Loans Program for the purpose of the administration and enforcement of the ALA. Administration and enforcement of the CAL means development and operation of the program, including investigations into allegations of wrongdoing, audits, and policy analysis, research, and evaluation. These activities may involve the matching of various sources of data that are under the control of the Government of Canada.

Your personal information is administered in accordance with the ALA and ALR, the *Department of Employment and Social Development Act*, the *Privacy Act*, and other applicable laws. You have the right to the protection of, access to, and correction of your personal information, which is described in Personal Information Bank ESDC PPU 709.
